Andrews Man Arrested for Manufacturing Marijuana

(Andrews, SC)—Members of the Georgetown County Organized Crime Bureau (OCB) arrested 38-year-old Jonathan Erik Svedberg, of 304 South Cedar Street, Andrews, SC, on July 19, 2009 for Manufacturing Marijuana. Svedberg was arrested after he was observed pulling up 33 Marijuana Plants out of his back yard.

On the evening of July 19, 2009, members of the Andrews Police Department contacted the OCB and advised them they received a anonymous call that Marijuana was being grown at 304 South Cedar Street in Andrews. When a member of the OCB arrived at this location, he was met by an Andrews Police Officer that advised him he observed Svedberg come out of the residence and pull up several Marijuana Plants he had growing in the back yard. Once Svedberg pulled up the Marijuana Plants, he placed them in the back of truck parked in the driveway. Once the Marijuana Plants were observed by the OCB, Svedberg was placed under arrest.

After Svedberg was placed under arrest, his residence was searched which lead to the seizure of drug paraphernalia and a small amount of Marijuana.

Svedberg was released from the Georgetown County Detention Center on July 21, 2009 after posting a surety bond.
