### Two Suspects Identified for Armed Robbery

(Georgetown, SC) --- Georgetown County Sheriff's Investigators have charged two (2) males for a strong armed robbery which occurred in the Murrells Inlet Community of Georgetown County.

At approximately 11:30 p.m. on May 2, 2014, one (1) black male suspect entered Not 2 Shabby located at 5190 Highway 17 Bypass through the unlocked front door. The suspect pointed what appeared to be a hand gun at the victim and demanded money. The suspect then fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of cash in an unknown direction of travel.

Through an extensive investigation, two (2) suspects were identified and arrested. Samuel Tyrice Coleman, 24 years of age, of 48 Bragdon Avenue in Georgetown is charged with one (1) count of Armed Robbery While Armed with a Deadly Weapon, and one (1) count of Possession of a Weapon During a Violent Crime. Soloman J. Coleman, 48 years of age, of 1223 Indian Hut Road, Georgetown is charged with one (1) count of Armed Robbery While Armed with a Deadly Weapon.

Samuel Coleman and Soloman Coleman are currently being housed at the Georgetown County Detention Center.
