Two Charged with Murder in Plantersville Club Shooting

(Georgetown, SC) --- Georgetown County Sheriff's Investigators have charged two (2) with Murder in the March 15, 2011 shooting at a Plantersville Club.

Investigators have charged 21 year old Camron Lamar Green of 7979 Ole Bellamy Dr. in Conway & 31 year old Lavern Holmes of 752 Lot Dr. in Georgetown with the Murder of 26 year old Deon Myers.

On March 15, 2011 Georgetown County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Club "Ghost Den" which is located at 2001 Jackson Village Rd. Deputies arrived on scene and discovered 26 year old Deon Myers on the floor with a gunshot wound to the face.

Witnesses on scene stated that three (3) unknown males entered the club wearing masks, one (1) carrying what appeared to be a shotgun and took Mr. Myres outside. Once outside witnesses stated they heard a single gunshot. Then the suspects fled the area in what appeared to be a burgundy in color Mercury Sable in an unknown direction of travel.

Mr. Myers was transported the Georgetown Memorial Hospital for treatment and later transport to MUSC in Charleston, SC where he succumbed to his injuries today.
