Pawley's Island Woman in Custody for Attempted Murder

(Pawley's Island, SC) --- This afternoon a Pawley's Island woman is in custody after she intentionally hit two (2) pedestrians with her vehicle.

On March 18, 2011 at approximately 10:16 am Georgetown County Deputies responded to the area of Ben Horry Trail in reference to a pedestrian that had been hit by a vehicle.

Georgetown County Sheriff's Investigators have charged Ivory R. Wilson of Pawley's Island with two (2) counts of Attempted Murder after she intentionally hit two (2) female pedestrians, turned her vehicle, a green in color SUV, around and again hit one (1) female pedestrian a second time. This incident stemmed from a dispute Wilson had with one of the pedestrians earlier this morning. One (1) pedestrian has been transported the Georgetown Memorial Hospital. The other was transported to the Waccamaw Medical Center for treatment of their injuries.

While Deputies were enroute to this incident a drive by shooting incident was dispatched on Grate Ave. where the suspects' vehicle was involved. Georgetown County Sheriff's Investigators are investigating this incident and have developed leads that the two (2) incidents are related. There are no known injuries in this incident.
