Suspects Charged for Multiple Burglaries on Highmarket Street

(Georgetown, SC) --- Georgetown County Sheriff's Deputies arrested four (4) suspects in connection with a burglary at the Stein, Inc., located at 3995 Highmarket Street in the Graves Station Community of Georgetown County.

At approximately 11:30 p.m. on December 29, 2013, Georgetown County Sheriff's Deputies conducting property checks in the Graves Community of Georgetown County observed a vehicle with three (3) white males and one (1) white female parked sideways at the entrance to Stein, Inc. While sheriff's deputies were interviewing the four (4) suspects in the vehicle, a property check revealed forced entry into an office trailer.

Georgetown County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Ashton David McElveen, 24 years of age, of 2602 Rion Street, Georgetown, South Carolina, Ryan O'Neil Woodruff, 20 years of age, of 496 Alligator Lane, Andrews, South Carolina, Joshua Andrew McBride, 25 years of age, 304 Meadow Street, Georgetown, South Carolina, and Hunter Brandy Haselden, 18 years of age, of 128 Owens Corner Drive, Hemingway, South Carolina.

McElveen is charged with Trespassing, Petit Larceny, and Second Degree Burglary. Woodruff is charged with Receiving Stolen Goods and Second Degree Burglary. McBride is charged with Receiving Stolen Goods and Second Degree Burglary. Haselden is charged with Receiving Stolen Goods and Second Degree Burglary.

On December 30, 2013, Georgetown County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence on Highmarket Street which was burglarized. After reviewing the property in evidence, sheriff's investigators determined that three (3) of the aforementioned suspects committed this crime as well. Woodruff is charged with First Degree Burglary. McElveen and McBride are charged with Second Degree Burglary.

As a result of further investigation, Georgetown County Sheriff's Investigators determined that Woodruff and McBride committed a previous burglary at a residence on Highmarket Street which occurred on December 19, 2013. As a result, Woodruff and McBride are charged with First Degree Burglary.
